CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLYDE F. MCKINNEY

of Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Branch Palmer Creek a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 15904 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Holdridge DLC 56, Section 30, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 9.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Holdridge DLC 56
- 5.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Holdridge DLC 56
- 0.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Turner DLC 55
Section 29
- 3.3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Holdridge DLC 56
- 1.9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Holdridge DLC 56
Section 30

Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at a point on the N. line of the Thomas L. Turner DLC #55 within Sec. 30, T 4 S., R 3 W., W.M., in Yamhill County, Oregon, 403.36 ft. W. of the NE corner of said Thomas L. Turner DLC; thence N. 2032.8 ft. to the N. line of the Francis Holdridge DLC #56; thence E. along said DLC line 505.56 ft.; thence S. 2376.0 ft. to the center of a county road; thence W. along the center of said county road 102.3 ft.; thence continuing along the center of said county road in a northwesterly direction 459.0 ft. to the N. line of the Thomas L. Turner DLC; thence W. 33.76 ft. to the point of beginning and containing 24.15 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
