CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That FRANK, ALBERT & ALFRED VANAKEN

of Route 1, Box 379 A, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17639 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 27, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Gibson DLC #44, Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. O. Gibson DLC #53
13.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. O. Gibson DLC #53
Section 18
Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.
13.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. O. Gibson DLC #53
23.7 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. O. Gibson DLC #44
4.9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. O. Gibson DLC #44

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the S. line of said W.O. Gibson DLC which is N. 69° 10' E. 18.08 chains from the SW corner thereof; thence along said claim line N. 69° 10' E. 13.64 chains to a fence postmarked "Corn. Post"; thence N. 24° 43' W. 62.99 chains to a rock in the original SW corner of mill site; thence N. 13° 30' W. 2 chains to the center of the Tualatin River; thence following the center of said river with its meanderings S. 52° 8' W. 3.11 chains; thence S. 26° 9' W. 4.77 chains; S. 67° 20' W. 2.62 chains; S. 55° 6' W. 3.49 chains; thence S. 47° 15' E. 4.26 chains; S. 36° 36' W. 4.60 chains; S. 10° 48' E. 4.64 chains; S. 24° 44' W. 2.37 chains; S. 13° 28' W. 3.23 chains; S. 67° 51' E. 2 chains; S. 59° 52' E. 2.82 chains; S. 52° 33' E. 5.86 chains S. 24° 3' W. 5.08 chains; S. 16° 29' W. 3.30 chains; S. 79° 38' E. 5.04 chains; S. 56° 11' E. 70 chains; thence leaving said river S. 26° 59' E. 8.68 chains to an iron pipe in the center of the County Rd.; thence along the center of said road N. 83° 13' E. 2.55 chains to an iron pipe; thence S. 23° 15' E. 17.62 chains to the place of beginning and containing 93.80 acres more or less, subject however, to right-of-way 60 ft. in width extending across a portion of said premises and conveyed to Washington County, Oregon, for road purposes by deed recorded May 10th, 1926, in book 133, page 43, of said Washington County Deed Records.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
