CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That R. GLENN, PAUL A., & R. CURTIS RITCHEY

of Route 1, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek and Gales Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13781 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 13, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.65 cubic feet per second, being 0.95 cfs from Carpenter Creek and 1.7 cfs from Gales Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Knighton DLC #146, Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M., & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Naylor DLC #37, Section 1, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M., both from Gales Creek, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, both as projected within Parsons DLC #40, Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 2, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M., all from Carpenter Creek. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
