CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GERALD BUCK

of Route 2, Box 67-A, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed gulch a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of stock & domestic, including irrigation of $\frac{1}{2}$ acre garden under Permit No. 18975 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 9, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from April 2 to October 31,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

stock in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
domestic & garden in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Vol. 306, page 50-1-2 of the Jackson County Deed Records describe the applicants land as being lands in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying E. of the Big Applegate River and in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying E. of the Big Applegate River excepting ten acres lying against the Eastern boundary line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Also the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and that portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying E. of the Big Applegate River, in Sec. 30 T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W.M., all in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
