CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. D. PARSON

of 1718 - 23rd Ave., Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Galess Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19121 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 17, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:11.8 acres in the Sassage as projected within J. Caine DIC #61 light acres in the Sassage as projected within J. Caine DIC #61 Section 8
