CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HOWARD & MAGALENE BAKER

of Route 1, Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lambert Slough a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20537 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1951.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Andrew Lason DLC #54, Section 9, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 7.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Cooper DLC #53
5.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Cooper DLC #53
Section 9
Township 5 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
All of the following described real premises lying W. of the State Highway running from Salem, Ore. to Dayton, Ore., being Ore. State Highway #221; beginning at a point on the W. line of Enoch Cooper DLC #53, Not. #1490, in T5S, R3W, W.M., Oregon & being a part of said Cooper Claim 16.87-2/3 chains N. of the Sth corner of said claim; running thence E. on the S. line of Lot #4, 53.20 chains to a stake on E. boundary of claim at NE corner of Lot 5 & SE corner of Lot 4; thence S. 7.87 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains; thence W. 21.75 chains to center of County Road; thence N. 3°30' E. 2.12 chains; thence W. 31.97 chains to W. line at SW corner of Lot 5 & NW corner of Lot 6; thence N. 5.75-2/3 chains to the place of beginning containing 35.35 acres more or less, saving and excepting therefrom 5.00 acres conveyed by G. L. Fowler et ux to Ivan Crawley et ux.

The said 16 acres comprises all of the Baker property above described.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
