CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. F. DENTON

oflll Pacific Building, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation & domestic use for 2 families

under Permit No. 21229 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second, being 0.15 cfs for irrigation & 0.02 cfs for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the INVANE's, as projected within Hannon DLC #12, Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth—of one cubic foot per second per acrepr its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.1 acres in the SWISE's Section 28

Domestic & 7.7 acres in the NWINE'S Section 33

both as projected within Hannon DLC #42 Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W. N.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
