CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. E. LIMPUS

of 1705 Burch St., Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21481 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 9.6 acres in Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)

0.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Yates DLC #44

1.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 8

1.6 acres in Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 7

Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Part of Sec. 7 & 8, T1S, R3W, W.M., & described as follows: Beginning at a point marked "A-11" in the county road, said point being 10 chains E. of the SW corner of Sec. 8 & running thence W. 3.40 chains; thence N. 0°45' W. 9.75 chains to the center of the Tualatin R.; thence N. 13° E. 2 chains; thence N. 27° W. 8 chains; thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 3 chains; thence N. 50° W. 8 chains to the E. line of the A.T. Smith DLC in T1S, R3W, W.M., thence N. 39° E. on said claim line 8 chains; thence S. 77°45' E. 5.52 chains; thence S. 62° E. 5 chains; thence S. 55° E. 4 chains to the center of the county road; thence southerly along the center line of said county road 27.99 chains to the place of beginning, save & excepting that tract conveyed to Washington County by deeds recorded in Vol.131, page 522, & Vol.141, page 538, & that tract conveyed to B.G. Brimson by deed recorded in Vol.242, page 417 of Washington County, Oregon, Deed Records.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
