CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLEN A. HEATON

of P. O. Box 593, Oakland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 22168 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 3. 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SWLWL, Section h, Township 25 South, Range 5
West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.25 acre in the SWINWI

Section 4 Township 25 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a \(\frac{1}{4} \) section corner on the line between Sec. \(\lambda \) \(\lambda \), T 25 S., R 5 W., thence running N. 1°30' W. on the section line 7.12 chains to the center of the county highway, thence following center of same, to-wit: S. 86°00' E. 1.93 chains, S. 70°\l5' E. \(\lambda \). 22 chains, N. 81°15' E. 2.21 chains, N. 65°00' E. 2.21 chains center line of Highway 99, N. 65°00' 6.50 chains to center of Calapooya Creek, thence down center of same, to-wit: S. 11°30' W. 1.00 chains, S. 8°00' E. 3.60 chains, S. 15°15' E. 3.16 chains, S. 23°30' E. 1.5\(\text{chains} \), Chains, S. 16°\(\lambda \) 15' E. 3.19 chains to the N. line of Reason Reed DLC, thence S. 78° W. on the N. line of said claim 16.18 chains to the section line between Sec. \(\lambda \) 5, thence N. 1°30' W. 6.50 chains to the place of beginning. All lying in Sec. \(\lambda \), T. 25 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Douglas County, Oregon, and containing 16 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
