CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SMITH RIVER LUMBER COMPANY
of Drain, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
Elk Creek, tributary of Umpqua River, to be appropriated under Application
No. 26684, Permit No. 21257,

for the purposes of
maintaining log pond

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1354 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1951

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed 119.0 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 12 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) , Tp. 22 S. , R. 6 W. , W.M.
