**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** RICHARD & MARGARET STRITZKE

of Winchester, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19286 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 3, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, Township 26 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.2 acres in Lot 5 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
0.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 20  
Township 26 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the left bank of the N. Umpqua River where it is intersected by the N. & S. line through the center of Sec. 20, T 26 S., R 5 W., W.M., running thence S. 89°15' W. 293 ft., S. 80°19' W. 269.0 ft. & S. 73°37' W. 637.9 ft. along the S. or left bank of the said N. Umpqua River thence S. 1695.4 ft.; thence E. 1114.1 ft.; thence N. 1°40' E. along said N. & S. center line 1939.4 ft.; to the place of beginning being a part of Lot 5 & the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 20, T. 26 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
