CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* EDITH JUNE WALKER & CLARE THOMPSON WALKER

of 2332 B Street, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19567 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, both as projected within Tupper DLC #42, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 2.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13
- 4.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14

both as projected within R. Tupper DLC #42
 Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: That part of the R.S. Tupper DLC #42 in T 1 S., R 4 W., W.M., particularly bounded & described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the SW corner of a tract of 3.90 acres conveyed in 1885 by Thos. J. Reed & Sarah A. Reed, his wife, to D. M. Dunbar, running thence S. 74°30' E. with S. line of said tract 3.90 acres, 14.05 chains; thence N. 28°45' E. 6.44 chains to a post; thence N. 69°45' W. 5.90 chains to center of creek; thence S. 85°30' W. up center of said creek 4.82 chains; thence S. 57° W. up said center of creek 0.48 chains; thence S. 86°30' W. up said center of creek 2.60 chains; thence N. 82°30' W. 1.51 chains to a stone in county road; thence S. 32° W. in county road 3.92 chains to place of beginning & containing 7.91 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
