CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT DUNIFER

of Illio S. Water, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek

a tributary of Pudding River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 22327 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 16, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\mathbb{N}_1^{1}\mathbb{N}\mathbb{E}_{\frac{1}{2}}^{1}$. Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, \mathbb{N}_{\bullet} M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ came feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acres in the SW1NE1 Section 2
Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at SE corner of tract of land deeded by A. F. Ekman and wife to Alice M. Aiken on the 12th day of September 1882, said deed being recorded in Book of Deeds, Vol. 28, Page IIII, Marion County, Oregon, Records, & running thence S. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 3.63 chains; thence N. $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 2.75 chains; thence N. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 3.63 chains; thence S. $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 2.75 chains to the place of beginning and containing one acre of land, situated in Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
