CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That T. W. BUMP

of Route 1, Brooks, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Kraus Creek & reservoir constructed under App. No. R-25171, Per. No. R-1115 a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 20173 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 23, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1115,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 10.0 acres in Lot 7 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Section 7

Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at a point 69 links S. 87°30' E. from the most westerly NW corner of the David T. Sewell D.C. in T 6 S., R 1 W., W.M., Marion County, Oregon; thence S. 87°30' E. 10.00 chains to the 1/4 section corner between Sec. 7 & 18; thence E. 9.27 chains to a reentrant corner in the W. boundary line of the Sewell Claim. Thence N. 1°15' E. 37.38 chains along the W. boundary line of said Sewell Claim to a point 2.20 chains from the most northerly N.W. corner of the Sewell Claim said point being the SE corner of land owned by V. Mattier along the N. boundary of the Elisha Veasy Claim. Thence N. 45° W. 2.48 chains. Thence W. 9.65 chains, thence N. 64°15' W. 4.41 chains to the center of the county road leading from Howell Prairie to Parkersville. Thence S. 32°45' W. 27.00 chains along said road to the W. road to the W. line of the Veasy Claim. Thence S. 8.50 chains to the NW corner of 10 acre tract of land owned by G. L. Vinton. Thence N. 89°30' E. 10 chains. Thence S. 9.42 chains to the place of beginning, containing 92.22 acres of land. By this conveyance all the land is conveyed lying E. of the county road leading from Howell Prairie to Parkersville in the Elisha Veasy Claim except that heretofore conveyed.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
