CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **WEYERHAEUSER TIMBER COMPANY,**
A Washington Corporation
of **Box 812, North Bend**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Woodruff Creek
a tributary of **Millicoma River** for the purpose of
domestic use in **13 houses & 8 unit apartment bldg. & logging camp**
under Permit No. **17170** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **July 25, 1946**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.25 cubic foot per second, being 0.12 cfs for domestic & 0.13 cfs for logging
camp,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 9 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)**, Section 8, Township 25 South,
Range 11 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

**Lot 9 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Lot 10 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Lot 8 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8
Township 25 South, Range 11 West, W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
