CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That CLYDE BAUMAN

of Route 2, Box 296, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 17262 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 7, 1950 for 0.38 cfs

March 23, 1950 for 0.03 cfs; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.41 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within McKay DLC #43, Section 28, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 6.6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 10.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- Section 28
- 8.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 7.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 28.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 36.6 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 0.9 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- 4.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. McKay DLC #43
- Section 29
- Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the S. boundary of the John C. McKay DLC #43 in Sec. 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, & 30 in T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M., in Marion County & State of Oregon, 26.25 chains from the SE corner of said claim; thence running W. along said boundary 37.18 chains; thence N. 23.50 chains to the division line between the N. & the S. halves of said DLC; thence E. along said division line 12.90 chains; thence S. 7.50 chains; thence E. 24.48 chains; thence S. 16 chains to the place of beginning & containing 69 acres of land, more or less, all situate in Marion County, Oregon.

Beginning at the SE corner of the DLC of John C. McKay & Josetta McKay in T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M., thence W. along the S. boundary of said claim 26.25 chains; thence N. 16 chains; thence W. 24.28 chains; thence N. 7.50 chains to the division line between the N. & S. half of the said McKay's DLC; thence E. along said division line 50.53 chains to the E. line of the aforesaid claim; thence SW 23.50 chains to the place of beginning, containing 80 acres, more or less, all situated in Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
