and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume I, at page 57; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1885 for Tract Tract No. 1 and 1877 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days or 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1 from Hay Creek - 28.3 acres in the SELNEL; 33.6 acres in the NELSEL; 37.7 acres in the SELSEL of Section 7; 18 acres in the NELNEL; 11.5 acres in the NVLIEL; 3.3 acres in the SVLIEL and 12 acres in the SELNEL of Section 16, T 10 S. R. 15 E. W. M., in Jefferson County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Wilson Creek - 13.7 acres in the NPLNEL; 0.7 acres in the NVLNEL of Section 8, 8.1 acres in the SELSW and 16.4 acres in the SWLSEL of Section 5 T 10 S. R. 15 E. W. M., in Jefferson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
