CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JEWEL ICE CREAM COMPANY

of Warren, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Sly Creek & reservoir constructed under App. No. R-19877, Per. No. R-1049 a tributary of Scappoose Bay for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 19630 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second and 9.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 25, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow for lands described as primary and further limited to 9.0 acre feet stored water only from reservoir on lands described as supplemental and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1049,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.9 acres supplemental in Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 11.6 acres supplemental in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Fullerton DLC #44
- 24.6 acres supplemental in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Fullerton DLC #44
- 2.3 acres (1.6 supplemental, 0.7 primary) in Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 14.4 acres primary in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Fullerton DLC #44
- Section 25
- 0.7 acres supplemental in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within R. Fullerton DLC #40
- 9.8 acres supplemental in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 2.8 acres supplemental in Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
- Section 36
- Township 4 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
