CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That P. H. SEELY

of Route 2, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17128 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Townsend Not. 876, Section 21, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one~~ ^{one} ~~eightieth~~ ^{eightieth} of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 20.1 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G.G. Townsend Not 876
4.8 acres in Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.1 acres in Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
5.1 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G.G. Townsend Not. 876
Section 21

Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.
Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at a point in the middle of Pudding River 2.05 chains E. from the SE corner of the DIC of Thos. Fitzgerald in T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M., Marion County, Oregon; thence E. 11.215 chains to the W. line of the DIC of G.G. Townsend; thence N. 1° 08' W. 10.96 chains to the NW corner of the Wm. Komp land; thence S. 89° 45' E. 28.97 chains along the N. line of Wm. Komp's land to the W. line of the Oregonian Railroad; thence S. 13° 27' E. 2.986 chains along the W. line of said railroad; thence S. 10° E. 17.318 chains along the W. line of said railroad to the NE corner of a 10 acre tract described in Vol. 27, page 429 in the records of conveyances in the Recorder's Office for Marion County; thence N. 89° 30' W. 32.51 chains to the W. line of G.G. Townsend Claim; thence N. 1° 08' W. 85 links to the middle of Pudding River; thence down the main channel of Pudding River to the place of beginning, and containing 66.75 acres of land, all in Marion County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
