CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OAKLEY E. SMITH

of Route 1, Gaston , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Villamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18761 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 9, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 audic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWASEA, as projected within Tupper DIC #42, Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.4 acres in the SW4SB4
10.7 acres in the NW4SB4
1.6 acres in the SE4SW4
2.8 acres in the NE4SW4
Section 13
Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M. all as projected within Tupper DC #42

. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
