ond that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salesm, in the Order Record of the Frate Water no. Rep. of the State of Oregon, in Volume 7, at page 57; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days or 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 7 acres in the  $SW_2^1SW_2^1$  of Section 14 and 2 acres in the  $SE_2^1SW_2^1$  of Section 23, T 8 S. R. 16 E. W. M., in Wasco County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
