CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BURNELL OLSON

of Star Route, Newberg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Skookum Lake and unnamed stream a tributary of _____ for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20484 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second, water to be diverted from unnamed stream when available and any deficiency in the available supply from the stream to be made by diversion from Skookum Lake

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Waggoner DLC #66, Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.56 cfs,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 14.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within P. Waggoner DLC #66
1.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G. Alpin DLC #64
0.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G. Alpin DLC #64
Section 32

Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.
6.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within P. Waggoner DLC #66
21.8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within P. Waggoner DLC #66
1.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G. Alpin DLC #64
0.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G. Alpin DLC #64
Section 5

Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of county road on the W. boundary of & N $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 17.83 chains from the SW corner of Wagoner DLC #39 in T. 3 & 4 S., R. 2 W., W.M., thence along road N. 43°47' E. 10.55 chains, N. 62°30' E. 4.02 chains, S. 84°50' E. 4.60 chains; thence N. 86°50' E. 14.19 chains, thence N. 41°15' W. 14.00 chains to W. boundary of said claim thence S. $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 60.67 chains to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
