CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALLERON A. JOHNSON

, State of Oregon . , has made proof of Route 1, Yamhill to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Yambill River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 21898 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby

confirmed dates from November 21, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWASEA, as projected within T. Harris DIC #39, Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acreor its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.8 acres in the NWASWA, as projected within J. Perkins DLC #55 3.1 acres in the NW4SW4, as projected within T. Harris DLC #54 Section 30

Township 2 South, Range 4 West, W. M. 12.8 acres in the NE SEA, as projected within T. Harris DLC #39 0.3 acres in the SEISEI, as projected within T. Harris IEC #39

Section 25 Township 2 South, Range 5 West, W. M. Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
