CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ... GEORGE A. CLESSNER

of Neal Lane, Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 22100 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from key 25, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1SE1, as projected within Wright DLC #45, Section 27, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acres in the NW4SE4, as projected within Wright DLC #45
Section 27
Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the W. r/w line of Neal Lane 30.073 chains W. & 11.27 3/4
chains N. from the SE corner of the Lazarus Wright DLC #45 in Sec. 27, T. 29 S.,
R. 5 W., W.M., thence W. 513 ft., thence S. 01°38'30" E. 343.14 ft., thence E.
503 ft. to the W. r/w line of said Neal Lane; thence N. along the W. r/w line of
said Neal Land 343 ft. to the place of beginning, all in Sec. 27, T. 29 S., R. 5
W., W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
