CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BERNARD J. LARSEN

of Ster Route, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cales Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 22188 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the ESW2, as projected within M. W. Watts DLC #48,
Section 27, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acress its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

5.8 acres in the NE4SW4 10.0 acres in the NW4SE4 Section 27

Township 1 North, Range h West, W. M. both as projected within M. W. Watts DLC #48

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Part of the M.W. Watts DIC #18, T. 1 N., R. 1 W., beginning on the W. boundary
of said claim at a point in the center of the county road from which an iron
corner bears N. 30 ft. & the ME corner of the George W. Fearnside DIC bears N.
32.51 chains & running along said county road N. 71°52° E. 5.00 chains, S. 69°
26° E. 1.655 chains, S. 73°10° E. 5.515 chains; thence S. 65°3° E. 6.061 chains,
N. 89°11° E. 2.720 chains, to the center of the culvert, S. 39°2° E. 13.290
chains; thence leaving said road & running S. 51°53° W. 17.133 chains to a post
& continuing said course to the center of Gales Creek, thence up said creek
following the meanders thereof to the W. line of said claim, thence along same
N.12.00 chs. more or less to the place of beg., containing 57.79 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
