This Is to Certify, That BEN J. OLSON

of Route 1, Jefferson , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Thomas Creek

a tributary of South Santiam River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 21131 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the stream, as projected within Officer DLC #63, Section 21, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toons—cightieth of one cubic foot per second per acrer its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

S. 86° E. along center line of said rd. 26 chains; thence S. to the center of Thomas Creek; thence southwesterly following down the center of said Thomas Creek to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
