CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That H. B. TAYLOR

of Antelope State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Antelope Creek, a tributary of Trout Creek, Lord's Creek and Grub Hollow Creek, tributaries of Antelope Creek

for the purpose of the irrigation of 39.75 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 57 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1901 for irrigation and 1873 for stock use for Tract No. 1; 1896 for Tract No. 2 and 1895 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days or 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1 from Antelope Creek - 7.50 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 10.50 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, T 7 S. R. 17 E. W. M., in Wasco County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Lord's Creek - 6.50 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 3.50 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, T 8 S. R. 17 E. W. M., in Wasco County, Oregon.

Tract No. 3 from Grub Hollow Creek - 7.25 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 4 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, T 7 S. R. 17 E. W. M., and 0.50 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, T 8 S. R. 17 E. W. M., in Wasco County, Oregon.
