that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose's aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose's, and shall not exceed 1.00 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days or 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
