that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the EaSWas Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acres its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 2.2 acres in the SEASWA Section 6 9.4 acres in the NWANWA 0.1 acres in the SWANWA Section 7 Township 13 South, Range 3h East, W. M.

.. 1.5 acres in the NEANE Section 12 Township 13 South, Range 33 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
