CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That FRED BUESING of Klamath Falls State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Lost River, a tributary of Tule Lake

for the purpose of Stock and Domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 94 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.25 sec. ft. and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres from north side of Lot Two of Section Thirty-four, Township Forty South, Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
