**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That **MABEL LEWIS**

of 235 N. Jackson Street, Roseburg, State of Oregon <sup>97470</sup>, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19256 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.82 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Wm. Weaver DLC #39, Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 5.4 acres in the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- 6.8 acres in the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- Section 5
- 7.8 acres in the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- 16.5 acres in the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- 20.4 acres in the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- 8.8 acres in the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Weaver DLC #39
- Section 6

Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beg. at a point on the N. boundary line of the county rd., 2913.1 ft. S. & 834 ft. E. of the interior L corner of the Isaac Bailey DLC #40 in T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W.M., thence easterly 2375.9 ft. along the N. boundary of the aforesaid county rd.; thence N. 2841.4 ft. to the N. or left bank of the S. Umpqua River; thence upstream along the said N. or left bank of the S. Umpqua River to a point N. of the point of beg.; thence southerly & parallel to the E. line of the aforesaid Bailey DLC #40 to the place of beg., containing 114 acres, more or less, in Sections 5 & 6, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
