CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF M. M. MONNIER
 c/o Mrs. Vernis C. Monnier
 of Route 1, Box 169, Hubbard, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 an unnamed spring and unnamed stream
 a tributary of Brandy Creek for the purpose of
 irrigation
 under Permit No. 19466 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from April 17, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Dimmick DLC #64,
 Section 35, Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
 to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
 during the irrigation season of each year, water to be diverted from unnamed
 stream when available and any deficiency in the available supply in the unnamed
 stream is to be made up by diversion from unnamed spring, providing that the
 total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 1/80th c.f.s. for
 each acre irrigated,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 0.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 2.1 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 14.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 35
 Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. M.
 all as projected within A. Dimmick DLC #64

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
 Beg. at a point that is 2017.62 ft. E. of, S. 01°06' W. 1354.45 ft. from the NW
 corner of the A.R. Dimmick DLC, thence S. 01°06' W. 1298.09 ft.; thence E. 666.60
 ft.; thence N. 0°20' W. 1302.09 ft.; thence W. 642.31 ft. to the place of beg. &
 containing 19.40 acres, & located in T.4 S., R.1 W., W.M., Marion County, Oregon.
 Save and except all roads and roadways.

Tract numbered Sixteen (16) of DIMMICK HOMESTEAD TRACTS in Marion County, State
 of Oregon, as shown & designated on the duly recorded map and plat thereof on
 file & of record in Vol. 5, Page 29 Record of Town Plats for said county & State.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
