CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MICHAEL DEAN NEER

of Route 1, Box 37, Goble, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek (sometimes known as Burkhard Creek) a tributary of Goble Creek for the purpose of domestic use 1 family under Permit No. 19772 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 12
Township 6 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
Block 11 Near City

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
