## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That

the waters of Lost River, a tributary of Tule Lake

for the purpose of the irrigation of 297 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Francisco of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 94; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1864

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 742.5 acre feet during any irrigation season, and a quantity for domestic and stock purposes outside of the irrigation season at the rate of one-half second foot for each 1000 head of stock; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: 60 acres in the  $E_2^1NW_{4}^1$ : 37 acres in the  $SW_4^1W_{4}^1$ : 80 acres in the  $E_2^1SW_4^1$  and 40 acres in the  $SW_4^1SW_4^1$  of Section 7: 20 acres in the  $NE_4^1W_4^1$  and 40 acres in the  $NE_4^1W_4^1$  of Section 18, T 41 S. R. 14 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
