## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That

for the purpose of the irrigation of 261 acres of land, domestic and stock use

ond that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State water noarp of the State of Oregon, in Volume A at page 94. I that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1883

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 652.2 acre feet during any irrigation season, and a quantity for domestic and stock purposes outside of the irrigation season at the rate of one-half second foot for each 1000 head of stock; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: • 24 acres in the SELSEL of Section 21: 6 acres, in the SVLSVL of Section 22: 12 acres in the NELNVL; 37 acres in the NVLNVL; 8 acres in the SVLNVL; 16 acres in the SELNVL; 3 acres in the NELSVL; 6 acres in the NELSVL; 6 acres in the SVLSVL; 10 acres in the SVLSVL; 11 acres in the NVLSVL; 12 acres in the SVLSVL; 13 acres in the SVLSVL; 14 acres in the SVLSVL; 19 acres in the SVLSVL; 15 acres in the NVLSSEL and 2 acres in the SVLSSEL of Section 25, T 39 S. R. 112 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
