P. , State of , has made proof Yoncalla. to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Yoncalla Creek & pond constructed under App. No. R-29470, Per. No. R-1673 for the purpose of Elk Creek & Umoqua River a tributary of maintenance of log pond of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 23213 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 17, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE NW4, as projected within Burts DLC #40, Section 3, Township 23 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
