and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at puge 94; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually heneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 147.5 acre feet during any irrigation season, and a quantity for demestic and stock purposes outside of the irrigation season at the rate of one-half second foot for each 1000 head of stock; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 12 acres in the  $SW_4^1SW_2^1$  of Section 35, T 39 S., R  $11\frac{1}{2}$  E. W. M.,  $13\frac{1}{2}$  acres in Lot One; 10 acres in Lot 8 of Section 3;  $16\frac{1}{2}$  acres in Lot Five and 7 acres in Lot Twelve of Section 2, T 40 S. R. 11 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
