of Route 2. Box 207, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Tualatin River
a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

rrigation
under Permit No. 19585 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from June 23, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actuary beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SWANWA, as projected within Z. M. Rowell DLC

#45, Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acrept its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.2 acres in the SWANA, as projected within Z.M. Rowell DIC #15
13.8 acres in the SEANA, as projected within Z.M. Rowell DIC #15
6.0 acres in the NEASWA, as projected within Z.M. Rowell DIC #15
8.0 acres in the NEASWA, as projected within Z.M. Rowell DIC #15

Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Bag. on the N. line of the L.M. Rowell DIC #45, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M., where
the Scholls Bridge road crosses the said N. line, said point being N. 68° W.
2233 chains from NE corner of said claim 45, thence S. 22° W. 5.42 chains;
thence S. 0° .31 E. along center of said road 25.50 chains to division line
between the N. & S. halves of said claim 45, thence W. 19.00 chains to center
of Tualatin River; thence down said river with meanderings thereof to the N.
boundary.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
