CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That CHARLES J. SWINGLE

of Lorella State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Miller Creek, a tributary of Lost River and Oliver Swingle Springs, tributary to Lost River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 187 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4 at page 94 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1882 for Tract No. 1 and from 1870 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 467.5 acre feet during any irrigation season, and a quantity for domestic and stock purposes outside of the irrigation season at the rate of one-half second foot for each 1000 head of stock; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1 irrigated from Miller Creek - 40 acres in Lot Two; 20 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4; 35 acres in Lot Three of Section 7 T 40 S. R. 14 E. W. M., 40 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 35 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, T 40 S. R. 13 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 irrigated from Oliver Swingle Springs - A right to supplement the above right on the following lands: 17 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, T 40 S. R. 13 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
