CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HOWARD MARTIN

of Route 1, Box 430, Clackamas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dean Creek a tributary of Kellogg Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20409 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 2, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Matlock DLC #37, Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 1.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Matlock DLC #37
1.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Matlock DLC #37
Section 4
Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

beg. at the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on the W. boundary of Sec. 4, T2S, R2E, WM; thence N. 0°24' W. a distance of 126.6 ft. to an iron pipe driven in the N. boundary of the Wm. T. Matlock DLC; thence N. 68°38' E. tracing the N. boundary line of said DLC a distance of 454.6 ft. to a point on the easterly r/w line of the Cascade Hwy., said point being the true point of beg.; thence N. 68°38' E. along the N. boundary line of said Matlock DLC a distance of 164.3 ft. to center of 82nd St. County Rd.; thence tracing the center of said road S. 33°56' E. a distance of 499.8 ft.; thence S. 55°56' W. a distance of 294 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 33°56' W. 145.4 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 55°56' W. 7.2 ft. to the easterly r/w line of the Cascade Hwy.; thence along said hwy. r/w line as follows: -on an arc 1352.4 ft. radius curve to the right (the long chord of which curve bears N. 1°43' W. 33.4 ft.) a distance of 33.4 ft.; thence N. 14°01' W. a distance of 382.1 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 2.95 acres, more or less, exclusive of railroad r/w and public roads.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
