CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That: HOMER WILCOXEN

of Birkenfeld, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Nehalem River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21156 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 4, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.350 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 6 North, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
19.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 21
Township 6 North, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, T6N, R6W, W.M. in Clatsop County, Oregon.

ALSO: That portion of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28, T6N, R6W, WM, which lies W. of the Nehalem River, except therefrom the following: Beg. at the low water mark on the W. bank of the Nehalem R. & on the E. & W. line between the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Sec. 28 (a 3/4" ironpipe setting in the ground to mark starting pt.) thence W. along the said E. & W. line 59 rods to a maple stump 12" in diameter; thence on a straight line on about 15° angle from the said E. & W. line in an easterly direction to the W. bank of the Nehalem R., low water mark (1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " ironpipe setting in the ground to mark this pt.); thence in a southerly direction along low water mark on W. bank of the Nehalem R. to point of beg., in the County of Clatsop, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
