CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD J. PECK & IDA M. PECK

of Route 3, Box 654, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream & reservoir constructed under App. No. R-23800, Per. No. R-978 a tributary of Abernathy Creek for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 18807 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 11, 1949,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-978,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10
Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Being the following described portion of the Washington Williams DLC in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:
Beginning 30 chs. E. of the NW corner of that tract of land deeded to Eli Criswell by C. W. Porter and wife on October 13, 1896, which deed is recorded on page 389 of book 63 of the Deed Records of Clackamas County, Oregon; thence S. 20 chs; thence E. 5 chs; thence N. 20 chs; thence W. 5 chs; to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
