for the purpose of the irrigation of 100 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Wilter Bound of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at puge 94 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1898

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 250 acre feet during any irrigation season, and a quantity for domestic and stock purposes outside of the irrigation season at the rate of one-half second foot for each 1000 head of stock; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 18 acres in the SWINEL; 29 acres in the SEINEL; 36 acres in the NELSEL and 12 acres in the NWISEL of Section 23 and 5 acres in the NELWEL of Section 26, T 38 S. R. 112 E. W. M., in Klamath County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
