**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **FRED L. NORTON**

of 5115 SE Aldercrest Rd., Milwaukie, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Kellogg Creek and spring a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19708 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 400 gallons per hour

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Kellogg DLC #54, Section 6, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed the quantity allowed herein, water to be diverted from spring when available and any deficiency in the available supply in the spring is to be made up by diversion from Kellogg Creek, providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed one-eightieth cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Kellogg DLC #54  
Section 6  
Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at a point in the S. boundary of the Elisha Kellogg DLC #54 in T 2 S, R 2 E, W.M. which point is S. 89 418 E. 600 ft. distant from the SW cor. of said claim, running thence S. 89 41' E. tracing the S. boundary of said claim 150 ft; thence N. 0 04' W. parallel with the W. boundary of the Elisha Kellogg DLC, aforesaid 933.90 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 89 41' W; W. 150 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 0 04' E. 933.90 ft. to the place of beg.; subject to the rights of the public in that portion thereof within the county roads, all in Clackamas County Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
