CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Rt. 1, Box 231, Warren Oregon . State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and Borth Scappoose Creek for the purpose of

a tributary of : Scappoose Creek domestic use 1 family & irrigation

under Permit No. 21323 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 262 gallons per hour, being 12 gph from spring for documents & 250 gph from creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NECSE (dom.), NESELSE (irr.), Section 13.

Township 4 North, Range 3 West, W.H.

The amount of water used for irrigation; together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to cne-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

conjerm to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 0.4 acres & domestic in the SELSET. Section 13 Township 4 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
