Newberg , State of Oregon ; hus mude proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Chehalem Creek ; a tributary of Willamette River , for the purpose of steam power for electric light plant and supplying creamery Permit No. 1145 of the State Engineer, and that said right to nnder the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, mude and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume May, 1919 . 15th day of. at page 320 , on the the right hereby confirmed dates from April 27, 1912 ; thut the amount of. water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic feet per second. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: The City of Newberg, in Yamhill County, Oregon

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
