## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That EDGAR E. MILLER

of Rt. 3. Box 497, Hillsboro , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfact on of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek

a tributary we Dairy Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permi No. 22648 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 19, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEWNA, as projected within J. Johnson DLC 470. Section 6. Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrication season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.1 acres in the NETANWA, as projected within Johnson DLC #70 9.0 acres in the NWANWA, as projected within Johnson DLC #70 Section 6

Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W.M.
7.0 acres in the SELSW1. as projected within Johnson DLC #39
Section 31
