CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **GAIL P. BUFFINGTON**

of Rt. 2, Box 108, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mill Gulch a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation, domestic use 1 family and stock under Permit No. 23137 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres, domestic & stock in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 15

Township 39 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Description; as copied from Warranty Deed recorded in Jackson County Deed Records at Vol. 393, Page 74. Beg. at the quarter sec. cor. common to Sections 15 & 22, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M., Jackson County, Oregon, run thence along the line dividing the E & W $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 15, N 0° 06' 20" W 1746.17 ft. to the true point of beg., thence N 89° 42' 50" W 606.78 ft. to intersect the centerline of the Applegate River as now existing, thence along said line N 3° 40' 50" W 308.97 ft., thence S. 87° 04' 50" E 626.52 ft. to intersect the aforementioned E & W dividing line of Sec. 15, thence along said line S. 0° 06' 20" E 279.46 ft. to the true point of beg., tract containing 4.153 acres, more or less. EXCEPTING that portion of the above described tract lying within the right-of-way of the County Road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
