CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN J. CARLSON

of Route 1, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed stream formed by springs, a tributary of the Tualatin River, to be appropriated under Application No. 25034, Permit No. 20492,

irrigation for the purposes of

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1190 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 25, 1950,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 0.34 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 12 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Tp. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M. as projected within Humphrey DLC #39
