CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GARLAND MEADOR

of **Prairie City**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Dans Creek** a tributary of **John Day River** for the purpose of supplemental irrigation, domestic and stock under Permit No. **20464** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 15, 1951**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.47 cubic feet per second, being 1.45 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 8, & **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.5 acres, stock & domestic in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$**
Section 8.
24.8 acres in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$**
13.7 acres in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$**
Section 17

Township 13 South, Range 34 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

All that portion of the **N $\frac{1}{2}$** of **NE $\frac{1}{4}$** of Sec. 17, T 13 S, R 34 E, W.M., lying W. of a line beg. 1350 ft. W. of the NE cor. of said Sec. 17, aforesaid, being the NW cor. of the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** of said sec. & running at an angle of 32° W of S to the intersection of the current or tread of the John Day River where said river was running in the yr. 1871, & also lying N of the current or tread of said river where it was running on said date, & containing **23 $\frac{1}{2}$** acres, more or less. Also, all that portion of the **E $\frac{1}{2}$** of **NW $\frac{1}{4}$** of said sec. lying N. of the current or tread of said river where it was running in the year 1871. Also the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , **S $\frac{1}{2}$** of **NE $\frac{1}{4}$** of Sec. 8, T 13 S, R 34 E, W.M.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
